## How to Make a Sadaqa Tree for Kids (method and templates)

A Sadaqah Tree is a creative way to encourage children to give charity and do good deeds. Each time they give Sadaqah or perform a good deed, they add a leaf or fruit to the tree, making it a fun and visual way to track their kindness!

🗯 Materials Needed:

✓ A large piece of cardboard or poster board
✓ Construction paper (green for leaves, brown for the trunk)

✓ Scissors

✓ Glue or tape

- ✓ Markers or crayons
- ✓ Small stickers or paper coins (optional)

The templates are given below. You can use that too! And some of the sadaqa activities are mentioned in leaves, you can use it! And can write the new acts you do in the empty leaves.


#### Y Step-by-Step Instructions:

- Create the Tree Base
- $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$  Cut out a tree trunk from brown construction paper or draw
- it directly on the poster board.
- Glue or tape it onto the board.
- 2 Make the Leaves & Fruits
- Cut out green leaves from construction paper.
- Optionally, cut small fruits (apples, oranges, or dates) from colored paper.
- 3 Set Up the Sadaqah System
- Each time your child gives Sadaqah (money, food, or kindness), they add a leaf or fruit to the tree.
- You can write the good deed on the leaf before sticking it.


• If using stickers or paper coins, children can place them on the tree as "charity fruits."

#### 4 Keep Growing the Tree


- Encourage your child to fill the tree with good deeds throughout Ramadan or the entire year!
- Once the tree is full, discuss the impact of Sadaqah and encourage them to continue helping others.



































